Players Code of Conduct

The goal of the Branford Youth Basketball (BYB) Program is to build a strong foundation of basketball in our community that positively impacts the youths of our program. Providing Branford grades 2-8 to have an opportunity to grow and develop with their passion for the game.

- 1. I will treat the coaching staff respectfully.
- 2. I will respect the game and give my all during practice and games.
- 3. I will be respectful and courteous to my teammates and opposing team at all times.
- 4. I will be respectful in public and display good character as a representative of BYB.
- 5. If I have a problem with a teammate, I will talk to the coaching staff to attempt to solve the problem.
- 6. I will be committed to being a team player.
- 7. When I step on the court I will remember that "It's Time to Go to Work"
- 8. I will demonstrate sportsmanship, play fair and set an example.
- 9. I will not question, discuss or confront any officials during the game, but arrange time to understand call with my coach privately
- 10. I will value the instruction of my coach, and understand coaches volunteer their time to work with our team and not waste that time
- 11. I understand that BYB believes in honoring the game, game rules and development.

Parents Code of Conduct

As with players, parents/guardians also represent the Branford Youth Basketball (BYB) Program. We expect parents/guardians to act with a higher set of standards that we expect from our players as role models.

- 1. I will remember that the game is for, and about the youth basketball players not the adults
- 2. I will be a positive role model and encourage good sportsmanship
- 3. I will refrain from being demeaning and discouraging any official, coach, player, or parent
- 4. I will not use foul language, booing, taunting, screaming or make comments at or about players, coaches, fans or officials on my team or opposing teams.
- 5. I understand that I set the example, respective and courteous and that players will follow the example that I set allowing the young players to enjoy the game
- 6. I will value my child's commitment to BYB
- 7. I will offer applause and cheer encouragement following good play and great effort
- 8. Officials are part of the game, I understand that it is not a parents (or players job) to officiate the game.
- 9. I will value the instruction of my child's coach, and understand coaches volunteer their time to work with our team and not waste that time, if I have a matter I know that I can reach out to the coach privately
- 10. I understand that BYB believes in honoring the game, game rules and development of my child.

If parents fail to adhere to the Parents Code of Conduct, they will:

- 1. Receive a verbal warning for first offense
- 2. Be asked to leave the event upon second offense
- 3. May be suspended for a game, a season, multiple seasons or permanently from BYB events as decided upon the Branford Youth Basketball Board of Directors.
